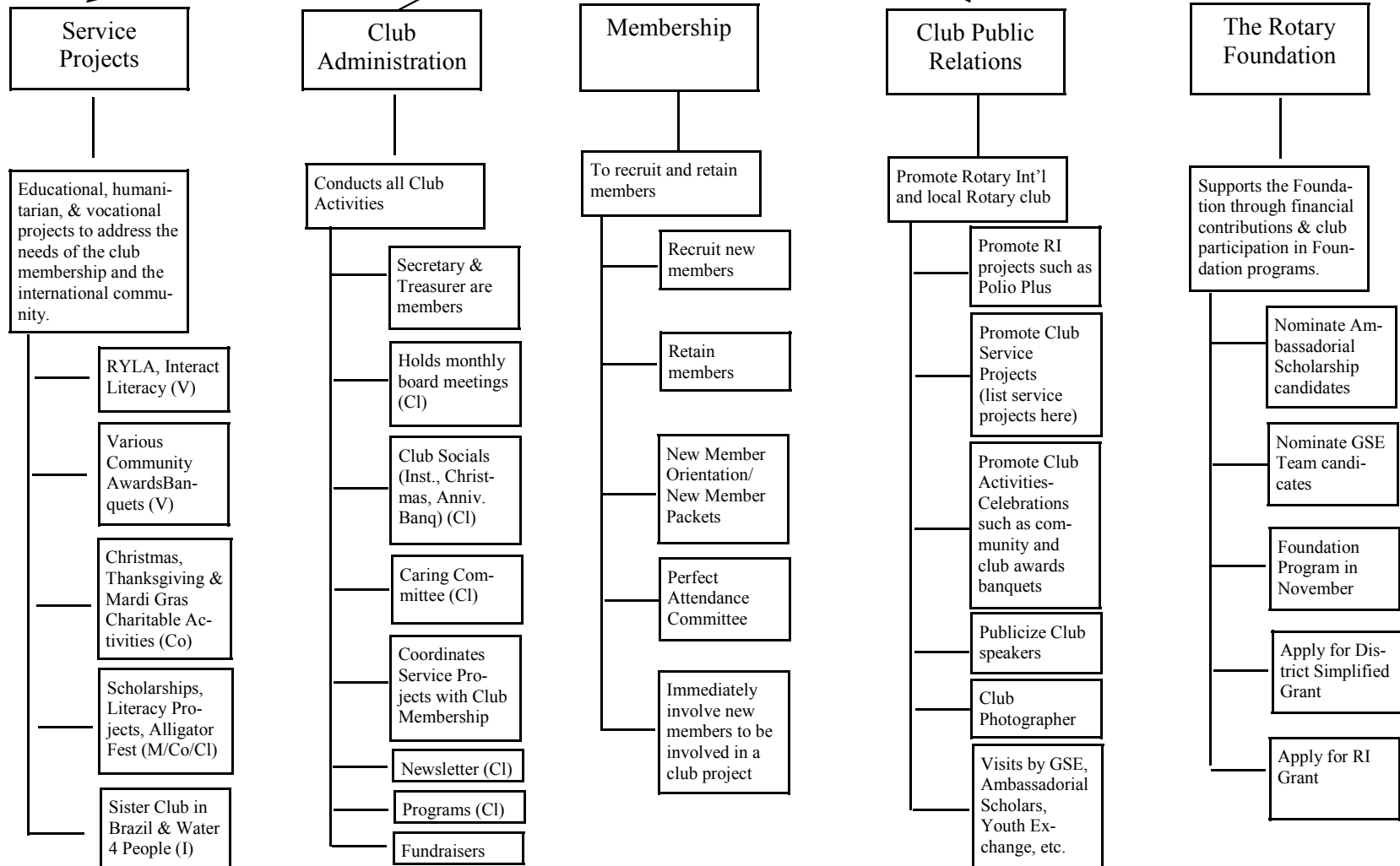


Sample Rotary Club Leadership Plan
